Why Charge an Adoption Fee?

Fees collected from the adoption of each animal help offset some of the costs involved in providing care for the animals and preparing them for placement in a forever home.

Please remember free pets usually come with no medical care, so while you may initially save on an adoption fee, the medical costs will add up quickly. Purchased pets are also often not spayed or neutered and may not have a full set of vaccinations, adding to the expense.



What does the Adoption Fee include?

- *Canine or feline distemper combination vaccination*
- *Rabies vaccination (if the animal is old enough)*
- *Spay/neuter surgery*
- *Microchip*
- *Deworming medication*
- *Adoption packet*
- *County license for the first year (dogs)*
